

CGHS General Parent Meeting
Monday, May 11, 2009

The parents were welcomed to the meeting by Ms. Flager.

The minutes from the April meeting were posted on-line. A motion to approve the minutes was made and seconded. The minutes were approved.

Ms. Schauben presented the group with a slate of nominees for the 2009-10 Board.
