What is the Progressive Dinner?

Every year since 2004, our CGHS Band/Color Guard/Orchestra Association has a special event designed to bring parents together for a wonderful evening of food, fun, and engaging conversation. You'll see Mr. H, some of the program's clinicians, and maybe even your student's Principal or Vice Principal. This is a great way for all to get to know each other!

In the past, we have had about 50 people attend. The event flows like this.....

Appetizers – At 6:30pm, participants (50 more or less) meet at a parent host/hostess home. This is where you will be given name tags and directions with a map to the dinner house and last of all, the dessert house. Part of the surprise is “where” you will be eating dinner!

Dinner – Around 8:00pm, the different groups have arrived at one of several “dinner” homes. These represent other parents that have volunteered to open their homes and cook dinner for 8 to 10 people, including themselves. Some of the groups have been as small as 6 and as large as 12.

Desserts – Around 9:30pm, participants (50 more or less) have arrived at the “dessert” host/hostess home to wind up the evening together again as one big group.

How this works?

This benefit has the cost of \$27.00 per person and all money raised goes to your CGHS program for band, orchestra, and color guard. Parent participants also bring an appetizer, dessert or adult beverage, which adds to the variety of food and drink to be shared by all. All “host homes” do not pay since their contribution is the dinner and beverages served at their home.
